**Requirements:****Entry Requirements:**

Sabana students need to complete 8 semesters of one of the following undergraduate degrees:

- Bachelor of International Business
- Bachelor of Business Administration
- Bachelor of Administration of Service Institutions

or 7 semesters of the Bachelor of Social Communication and Journalism.

Sabana students must have also achieved a minimum GPA requirement of 2.7 (out of 4) on the La Sabana grading System.
